1.DEFINITIONS

Unless the context otherwise requires:

- (a) "NCCF" means the National Cooperative Consumers' Federation of India Ltd. and includes its Head Office, Branch Offices and authorised representatives.
- (b) "Bidder" means the Cooperative Society/PACS/eligible entity submitting a bid in response to this Tender.
- (c) "Successful Bidder/Contractor" means the bidder whose bid has been accepted by NCCF and to whom the Letter of Award/Work Order/Contract has been issued.
- (d) "Raw Chana" means the Chana stock handed over by NCCF to the Contractor for processing under this Tender.
- (e) "Processed Chana" means the finished product obtained after processing, cleaning, grading, sorting and packing in accordance with the specifications prescribed by NCCF.
- (f) "Competent Authority" means the authority competent under the applicable NCCF Delegation of Powers/Procurement Policy to approve the tender, award the contract and take consequential contractual decisions.
- (g) "Contract" means the Tender Document, accepted bid, Letter of Award/Work Order, Agreement and all annexures/corrigenda/addenda forming part thereof.

1.Scope of Work

The Successful Cooperative Society/PACS shall undertake the processing of Raw Chana allotted by NCCF from designated locations in Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh and Gujarat (location-wise details are annexed.) and supply the processed Chana to various destinations across Chhattisgarh. The scope of work shall include, but not be limited to:

- a) Lifting of Raw Chana from the designated godowns.
- b) Transportation of Raw Chana to the Cooperative Society/PACS Cooperative Society and PACS unit.
- c) Cleaning, grading, Cooperative Society and PACS and processing of Raw Chana to obtain Cooperative Society and PACS Chana conforming to FSSAI and NCCF quality standards.
- d) Packing of the processed Chana in approved packaging (50 kg bags and/or 1 kg consumer packs, as specified by NCCF).
- e) Loading, unloading, handling and safe storage during processing.
- f) Transportation and delivery of the processed Chana to the designated godowns/distribution points across Chhattisgarh.
- g) Compliance with all applicable FSSAI, Legal Metrology, GST and other statutory requirements.
- h) The Cooperative Society/ shall bear all costs relating to labour, transportation, packing material, insurance, taxes, duties and incidental expenses until successful delivery.
- i) The Cooperative Society/ shall be responsible for any loss, damage, deterioration or shortage of stock during lifting, transportation, storage, Cooperative Society and PACS and delivery.
- j) The work shall be completed within the time schedule prescribed by NCCF and in accordance with all terms and conditions of the quotation document.

2.Bid information:

3.PROCESSING/MILLING ARRANGEMENT

- Where processing is proposed to be undertaken through a milling/processing agency, the bidder shall disclose the complete particulars of such agency along with the bid.
- The proposed processing agency shall possess all applicable statutory licences, registrations and approvals, including valid FSSAI registration/licence, wherever applicable, and shall have adequate installed processing capacity.
- No change or substitution of the disclosed processing agency shall be permitted without prior written approval of NCCF.
- The bidder and the approved processing agency shall remain jointly and severally liable to NCCF for due performance of all obligations under the Contract.

4.SUB-CONTRACTING

- The Contractor shall not assign, transfer, sub-contract or otherwise entrust the whole or any substantial part of the Contract to any third party without prior written approval of NCCF.
- The processing/milling agency specifically disclosed and approved by NCCF at the time of award shall not be treated as unauthorised subcontracting.
- Any unauthorised subcontracting shall constitute a material breach of Contract and may result in termination, forfeiture of security and other consequential action.

5.Terms & Conditions

- Cooperative Society/PACS must be the Lead/Principal Bidder.
- Private miller cannot independently bid.
- Agreement between PACS and miller must be valid for at least the contract period.
- Miller must possess required FSSAI licence.
- Miller must have adequate installed capacity.
- Miller must not be blacklisted.
- Miller must disclose ownership/control details.
- Lead bidder shall remain jointly and severally liable to NCCF for the entire contract.
- No substitution of miller without NCCF's prior written approval.
- NCCF may inspect both the PACS and milling unit.
- The Cooperative Society/PACS must be registered under GST and possess a valid FSSAI licence for pulse Cooperative Society and PACS/processing.

- l) The Cooperative Society/ shall have adequate Cooperative Society and PACS capacity, infrastructure, machinery and manpower to execute the work.
- m) The quoted rate shall be comprehensive and include all costs towards lifting, transportation, storage, cleaning, processing, Cooperative society, packing, loading, unloading, delivery, labour, insurance, taxes, duties and all incidental expenses.
- n) The quoted rates shall remain Cooperative Society/ and valid for the entire contract period. No escalation in rates shall be permitted.
- o) The Successful Cooperative Society/ shall maintain the prescribed quality standards of FSSAI and NCCF. Any sub-standard or rejected stock shall be replaced at the Cooperative Society/'s own cost.
- p) Quality issues from the time of lifting the stock until final delivery.
- q) Packing shall be done only in approved packaging and with artwork/markings prescribed by NCCF.
- r) Payment shall be released by NCCF on a back-to-back basis, subject to submission of valid invoices and supporting documents and subject to Payment Clause.
- s) NCCF reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids, cancel or modify the quotation, or allocate work to one or more Cooperative Societies/PACS without assigning any reason.
- t) The Successful Cooperative Society/PACS shall execute an agreement with NCCF before commencement of the work.
- u) The Cooperative Society/ shall comply with all applicable statutory provisions, including GST, Labour Laws, FSSAI, Legal Metrology and other Government regulations.
- v) The Cooperative Society/PACS shall not assign or sublet the work to any third party without prior written approval of NCCF.
- w) In case of delay, default or breach of any quotation condition, NCCF shall have the right to impose penalties, recover losses, forfeit the Security Deposit/EMD and terminate the contract.
- x) PACS milling unit must be present within the jurisdiction of the PACS.

6. Bid Validity and Responsiveness

- a) The Cooperative Society/PACS quoting the lowest rate (L1) will be awarded the quotation quantity as per the terms and conditions of this quotation.
- b) Only technically compliant bids will be considered for price evaluation.
- c) Bids not meeting technical and mandatory requirements shall be treated as non-responsive and rejected.
- d) Procuring authority shall not waive responsiveness requirements.
- e) Deviation from quotation specifications shall result in bid rejection.

7. VALIDITY OF BID

The bid shall remain valid for a period of **2 years** from the last date prescribed for submission of bids it may be extended or decreased.

During the validity period, the bidder shall not withdraw or modify its bid. In case of withdrawal in violation of this condition, NCCF shall be entitled to take action in accordance with the Tender conditions, including forfeiture of Bid Security/EMD, wherever applicable.

8.PERFORMANCE SECURITY

- a. The successful bidder shall furnish Performance Security of the total value of the work/quantity Rs 9 crores for all groups actually awarded within **3 days** from the date of issuance of the Letter of Award/Work Order.
- b. The Performance Security shall remain valid for the period prescribed by NCCF, including the applicable claim period.
- c. The exact percentage, permissible mode and validity period of Performance Security shall be specified in the Tender and shall not be left to determination after submission of bids.

9.Eligibility Criteria

1. The Cooperative Society/PACS shall be a registered Cooperative Society, registered under Cooperative Society and PACS act.
2. Consortium / Cooperative Society and PACS Agency Arrangement: Participation in the quotation shall be restricted to eligible Cooperative Societies. A Cooperative Society/PACS may participate by having a valid agreement with miller an operational Cooperative Society and PACS agency processing and packing facilities. The agreement with the Cooperative Society and PACS agency shall be valid for a minimum period of two (2) years from the date of submission of the quotation. A copy of the valid agreement shall be submitted along with the bid.
3. The Cooperative Society/PACS shall have a pulse Cooperative Society and PACS unit located in the State of Chhattisgarh with a minimum Cooperative Society and PACS capacity of 2,500 MT per month, including packaging and allied processing facilities.
4. The Cooperative Society/PACS shall possess a valid FSSAI Licence, GST Registration and PAN and all other valid license which are required for the above scope.
5. The Cooperative Society/PACS shall have a minimum turnover of **₹10Lakh** in pulses Cooperative society/supply business during the last two financial years. For participation in all five groups, the Cooperative Society/PACS shall have a minimum turnover of **₹50 Lakh**, supported by audited financial statements and a Chartered Accountant's certificate along with valid UDIN. (Government Supply/Cooperative Society and PACS/ PSU/Semi Government experience considered such work orders/completion certificate issued by the authorities must be furnished as a proof).
6. The Cooperative Society/PACS shall furnish proof of the Cooperative Society and PACS unit, such as electricity bills of the last two months and registration certificate or lease agreement.
7. The Cooperative Society/PACS shall submit an affidavit on a ₹100 non-judicial stamp paper declaring that the Cooperative Society/ has not been blacklisted by the Government of India, any State Government, PSU or any Government agency.
8. The Cooperative Society/PACS shall submit the prescribed Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) along with the bid, failing which the bid shall be rejected.
9. The Cooperative Society/ shall have the necessary infrastructure, manpower, machinery, transportation and financial capability to execute the work as per the quotation conditions.
 - a. NCCF reserves the right to verify the credentials and inspect the Cooperative Society and PACS before award of the contract. Only technically qualified Cooperative Societies/ shall be considered for financial evaluation.
 - b. The bidder/Miller should have successfully executed during the preceding two financial years at least two contract involving processing/cleaning/milling/packing/supply of pulses/food grains of a minimum quantity/value prescribed by NCCF.
 - c. The bidder shall demonstrate capacity sufficient to process the quantity allocated to it within the prescribed delivery schedule."

10.Security Deposit / Performance Security

- a) Successful Cooperative Society/ PACS shall submit SD in NEFT or RTGS form only contract value (Rs 9 Crores) within 3 days of award of contract. The validity will be up to completion of contract including warranty period. NCCF reserves the right to forfeit performance security in case of termination, breach of terms and conditions, non-compliance of instruction issues from NCCF time to time, etc.
- b) NCCF reserves the right to forfeit performance security in case of termination, breach of terms and conditions, non-compliance of instruction issued by NCCF from time to time etc.
- c) SD will not carry any interest.

EMD shall be forfeited if:

- Cooperative Society/PACS withdraws bid
- refuses work order
- fails to sign agreement
- fails to submit performance security
- submits false documents

11.Price & Financial Terms

- a) Prices must be Cooperative Society/PACS and inclusive of all taxes, duties, freight, insurance, packing, and forwarding, unless specified otherwise.
- b) Mandi Fee / Mandi Cess: Any Mandi Fee, Mandi Cess or other applicable market-related statutory levy on the purchase/lifting of Raw Chana shall be dealt with as per the provisions of the applicable Mandi Act, Rules and regulations. All other applicable taxes, duties, cess, levies and statutory charges shall be borne by the Successful Cooperative Society//Cooperative society, unless specifically provided otherwise in the Cooperative Society and PACS Agreement.
- c) GST shall be quoted separately as applicable.
- d) No escalation in price shall be allowed during the contract period.

12. Payment Terms

- 1) Payment shall be released to the successful Cooperative Society and PACS only after NCCF receives the corresponding payment from the concerned client department for the respective quantity supplied. NCCF will not be liable to make any payment if not received from the department for whatsoever reason.
- 2) No advance payment shall be made by NCCF under any circumstances.
- 3) All payments shall be subject to applicable statutory deductions and NCCF's approved service margin.
- 4) Cooperative Society and PACS must submit:
 1. Original GST invoice in the name of NCCF Raipur Branch;
 2. Proof of uploading invoice on GST portal (screenshot/ARN/IRN);
 3. Bank details & PAN copy.
- 5) NCCF shall release payment within 15 working days of receiving payment from the Department, subject to verification. Payment shall be made after inspection, and acceptance of goods, subject to submission of complete documents and proper invoice.
- 6) GST component will be released only if invoice is uploaded correctly and ITC is available.
- 7) Any denial/reversal of ITC due to Cooperative Society and PACS fault shall be recovered from the Cooperative society's bills/security.

- 8) Final payment subject to reconciliation and fulfilment of replacement/warranty obligations.
 - a. Payment shall be released against properly submitted invoices, delivery documents, weighment records, quality/acceptance certificates and other documents prescribed by NCCF, subject to verification and acceptance of the material/services.
 - b. Payment shall be made in accordance with the approved contractual rates and applicable statutory deductions.
 - c. Where the Contract is expressly linked to receipt of corresponding payment by NCCF from the concerned client/department, payment shall be governed by the specific back-to-back payment provision contained in the Contract.
 - d. No payment shall be treated as due merely upon submission of an invoice.
- 9). The Contractor shall quote GST separately, wherever applicable, unless the Financial Bid specifically requires an all-inclusive rate.
 - a. The Contractor shall ensure timely filing of all applicable GST returns and uploading of invoices/details so that the eligible Input Tax Credit of NCCF is not adversely affected.

Terms and Conditions: - (Technical Bid)

1. The Cooperative Society and PACS must be established in the state of Chhattisgarh/eligible work in the state, Mill must present in the state of Chhattisgarh. Minimum Milling Capacity of Cooperative Society and PACS of pulses 2,500 metric tons per month, including packaging and associated processes.
2. Copy of the license of Food Safety and Standards Authority of India for pulses business issued by the food safety authorities.
3. Copy of registration certificate of cooperative society, PAN card and GST certificate active status of the Cooperative Society/PACS.
4. For verification of turnover, it is mandatory to attach a certificate verified by a chartered accountant along with valid UDIN in the prescribed format.
5. Turnover will be accepted only of the Cooperative Society/ on whose behalf the quotation is being filled, the turnover of the subsidiary Cooperative Society/ or other Cooperative Society/ of that Cooperative Society/ will not be accepted.
6. Bank account number of the Cooperative Society/PACS(including IFSC code)
7. Photocopy of registration in case of Cooperative Society/PACS registered under Micro Small Medium Enterprises Development Act 2006.
8. Affidavit 100/- (on non-judicial stamp paper) that the Cooperative Society/PACS institution is not blacklisted by Govt. of India/any State.

9. NCCF reserves the right to negotiate with L-1 PACS, Cooperative Society wherever permissible under applicable procurement policy and in the interest of the Federation.
10. Our successful Cooperative Society/PACS has to enter the registered agreement with NCCF, which shall contain the detailed terms and conditions between the parties.
11. EMD of unsuccessful Cooperative Societies/PACS will be refunded, no interest will be paid on SD money.
12. NCCF shall be free to postpone/cancel the quotation and accept or reject any bid, without assigning any reason whatsoever.
13. Quotation Form - Envelope-I and Price Bid - Envelope-B shall be submitted in separate sealed envelopes.
14. Only the technical bid qualified Cooperative Society and PACSs' bids will be considered for financial evaluation. Quotation will be considered for negotiation and work contract will be awarded only after inspection of their Cooperative society.
15. Successful Cooperative Society/PACS has to submit the SD amount within stipulated time period as decided by NCCF in the form of NEFT/RTGS only. BG/FD are not accepted. SD will not carry any interest.
16. The Cooperative Society/PACS shall submit all the relevant and material documents in support of their eligibility as well as their bid.

14. Financial Bid -

1. Price Bid of the Cooperative Society/PACS who have not qualified in the Technical Bid will not be opened them.
2. EMD Amount: Per Group Rs 50,000 (Fifty Thousand) for all groups total 2,50,000 (Two Lakh Fifty Thousand Only). EMD refundable will not carry any interest.

By-product and Jute Sack Cost:-

- a. The quoted rate shall account for by-products equivalent to 8.50% of the raw Chana issued.
- b. The value of such by-products shall be payable to NCCF at the rate of ₹1,000 per quintal.
- c. The value of jute sacks relating to the raw stock shall also be payable to NCCF at the rate of ₹25 per bag.
- d. Both amounts shall be included or adjusted in the Cooperative Society/'PACS s quoted rate, and no separate claim shall be admissible.

Other: -

1. The branch manager will have full right to cancel/modify/increase-decrease the time period and distribution work without giving any reason.

3.The Security Deposit shall remain with NCCF until the satisfactory completion of the contract and shall be released without interest after settlement of all dues and after satisfactory completion of the work.

4.In case of default, NCCF reserves the right to forfeit the Security Deposit in full or in part and recover additional losses from the Cooperative society/PACS.

15.Payment Clause:

- a) Payment to the Successful Cooperative Society/PACS shall be made by NCCF strictly on a back-to-back basis.
- b) Applicable GST shall be paid only after the same is credited/appears in the Electronic Credit Ledger of NCCF on the GST portal (Form GSTR-2B).
- c) The Cooperative Society/ shall ensure timely and correct uploading of invoice details on the GST portal to enable NCCF to avail Input Tax Credit (ITC).
- d) Any delay in GST compliance by the Cooperative Society/PACS which results in denial or reversal of ITC to NCCF shall be recovered from the Cooperative Society/'s bills or security deposit.
- e) Statutory deductions such as TDS/TCS, if applicable, will be made at the time of release of payment.
- f) The payment shall only be released upon the Cooperative Society/PACS submitting a proper and valid bill/ invoice along with all relevant and material documents. Detailed agreement will be executed after successful completion of the bid.

16.OWNERSHIP AND CUSTODY OF NCCF STOCK

- a. All Raw Chana, processed Chana, by-products and other material supplied or entrusted by NCCF to the Contractor shall remain the exclusive property of NCCF unless expressly transferred in writing.
- b. The Contractor shall hold such stock in safe custody and shall not sell, pledge, mortgage, hypothecate, divert, transfer, commingle, dispose of or otherwise deal with NCCF's stock except strictly in accordance with the Contract and written instructions of NCCF.
- c. The Contractor shall be fully responsible for any loss, shortage, theft, diversion, deterioration, adulteration or unauthorized disposal of NCCF stock while the same remains in its custody or control.

17.NO LIEN OVER NCCF STOCK

The Contractor shall have no lien, charge or right of retention over any Raw Chana, processed Chana, by-products, packaging material or other property belonging to NCCF, irrespective of any dispute relating to payment or any other claim of the Contractor against NCCF.

18.STOCK ACCOUNTING AND RECONCILIATION

- a. The Contractor shall maintain separate and complete records of all NCCF stock received, processed, packed, dispatched, delivered, rejected, damaged, lost and remaining in stock.
- b. A daily/lot-wise stock reconciliation statement shall be maintained and furnished to NCCF whenever required.
- c. The Contractor shall produce the stock register, weighment records, delivery challans, laboratory reports and other relevant records for inspection and verification by NCCF.
- d. Any unexplained shortage shall be recoverable from the Contractor at the applicable contractual/replacement value, without prejudice to NCCF's other rights and remedies.

19.BY-PRODUCTS

- a. All by-products/recoverable material arising from processing of NCCF's Raw Chana shall be accounted for separately and shall remain the property of NCCF unless otherwise specifically provided in the Work Order.
- b. The quantity of by-products shall be jointly recorded and reconciled with the prescribed recovery norms.
- c. The Contractor shall not sell or otherwise dispose of any by-product belonging to NCCF without prior written authorization.
- d. Any unauthorized disposal shall render the Contractor liable for recovery of the value thereof, together with applicable damages/costs, without prejudice to other contractual remedies.

20. SAMPLING AND TESTING

- a. NCCF shall have the right to draw representative samples at the processing unit, during dispatch or at the destination.
- b. Sampling shall, wherever practicable, be carried out jointly and the samples shall be properly sealed and identified.
- c. NCCF may have the samples tested through an authorized/NABL-accredited laboratory or any other laboratory approved by NCCF.
- d. Where the material fails to conform to the prescribed specifications, the Contractor shall bear the cost of testing, transportation, replacement, reprocessing, disposal and all other consequential expenses attributable to such non-conformity.
- e. In case of a disputed test result, the procedure for retesting through an independent laboratory prescribed by NCCF shall be followed, and the result of such test shall be acted upon in

21. REJECTION

- a. NCCF shall have the right to reject any quantity which does not conform to the prescribed quality, quantity, packaging, labelling or other contractual requirements.
- b. Rejected material shall be removed/replaced by the Contractor within the period specified by NCCF at its own risk and cost.
- c. Rejection shall not relieve the Contractor from liability for delay, liquidated damages, risk purchase, testing expenses or any other contractual consequence.

22. PRODUCT RECALL

- a. If any batch of Processed Chana supplied by the Contractor is subsequently found to be adulterated, contaminated, unsafe, defective or otherwise non-compliant with applicable specifications or law, the Contractor shall, upon receiving notice from NCCF, immediately cease further dispatch and cooperate fully in identification, segregation and recall of the affected batch.
- b. All reasonable costs relating to recall, transportation, testing, replacement, destruction/disposal and consequential losses attributable to the Contractor shall be borne by the Contractor.
- c. The Contractor shall immediately notify NCCF of any food-safety incident, regulatory action, contamination or other event which may affect the safety or conformity of the supplied product.

23.Defects, Quality Rejection & Return Clause:

- a) The supplied Chana must strictly conform to the quality parameters and FAQ (Fair Average Quality) specifications prescribed by NCCF.

- b) Testing will be carried out at FSSAI / NABL-approved laboratories or as directed by NCCF.
- c) If any consignment is found to be substandard, adulterated, or not conforming to specifications, NCCF reserves the right to reject the entire lot or part thereof.
- d) The decision of NCCF regarding quality shall be final and binding on the Cooperative society.
- e) Rejected stock shall be taken back by the Cooperative Society and PACS at their own cost (including transportation, loading/unloading, and other incidental expenses) within 7 days of rejection notice.
- f) The Cooperative Society and PACS shall replace the rejected quantity with compliant material within the stipulated period.
- g) In case the Cooperative Society and PACS fails to lift/replace the rejected stock, NCCF shall be free to dispose of the stock at the Cooperative society's risk and cost, and recover the differential amount along with an administrative surcharge of 2% from the Cooperative society's bills or security deposit.

25.Inspection, Verification & Audit

- a) NCCF, its authorized representatives, Internal Auditors, Statutory Auditors, or any agency authorized by the NCCF shall have the right, at any time during the currency of the contract and thereafter, to inspect the Cooperative Society and PACS unit, warehouses, stocks, records, books of accounts, transportation documents, weighment records and any other documents relating to the execution of the contract.
